Opening:

The meeting of the Cleveland Animal Shelter Advisory Board was called to order at 1:05 PM on April 6, 2016 in the City Council Room of the Municipal Building by Dr. James Lane.

A. Approval of Minutes

George Poe motioned to approve the minutes as written. Jill Barrett seconded. All approved.

B. Director's Report

- 1) Director Gene Smith reported that Macy White's training had been completed and that she is currently at training for euthanasia.
- 2) Packets containing the Animal Control Monthly Reports were distributed.
- 3) Director Smith also noted that the spot on the board left vacant due to the passing Kathy Kinder would need to be filled. If anyone had a recommendation of someone to fill that position, it would need to be turned in to the Mayor.

C. Old Business

- 1) Andrea Hollingsworth addressed the board regarding the changing of the City ordinance regarding swine inside the City limits. Dr. Lane made a motion to go before the City Council that swine be allowed inside the City limits as long they are kept inside at least 75 percent of the time and are kept as pets only, not as livestock. Jill Barrett seconded the motion. All approved.

City Clerk Shawn McKay said that it could possibly be put on the City Council agenda for April 25, 2016. If it was approved in its first reading, then it would be put on the May 9, 2016 agenda for its second reading.

Beverly Lindsey said it's possible that it could go on a later agenda if the City attorney wanted to review the motion before it went on the agenda.
