NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING CLEVELAND URBAN AREA MPO

The Cleveland Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is facilitating public meeting for Cycle Cleveland and Walk Cleveland on Friday February 24, 2017 from 12:00 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. in the community meeting room at the Cleveland Public Library, 795 Church Street NE.

We will hear from bicycle and pedestrian experts from Nashville, Knoxville, and Chattanooga on how they organized bicycle and pedestrian planning and advocacy groups within their communities, and about their experience in promoting walking and biking facilities and issues. We will also hear from BikeWalkTN, a statewide advocacy organization. Discussion will include future organizational plans for Cycle Cleveland and Walk Cleveland, including the opportunity to partner as a local chapter under BikeWalkTN. There will be an update on Cycle Cleveland cycling safety and education outreach, including a proposed cycling event for later in 2017. As part of the discussion, we will also be hearing from the TN Walkability Learning Collaborative, an effort organized by the Knox County Health Department with participants from other Tennessee communities including Cleveland.

The Cleveland Urban Area MPO is a federally mandated organization responsible for transportation planning and transportation resource allocation within the Cleveland Urbanized area.
