

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE 2020-2023
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)
CLEVELAND URBAN AREA MPO**

The Cleveland Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) proposes to make two amendments to its 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program:

Proposed Amendment 2020-03 to the TIP adds a new project to the TIP, the Bradley-McMinn County Project No. 2006015, I-75, ITS Infrastructure and Network Improvements. Total project length is 22.86 miles from near SR-312 in Bradley County to near Coile Road (CR-114) in McMinn County . Funding for PE-N in FY 2023 is \$150,000 of NHPP funds and funding for PE-D in FY 2023 is \$350,000 of NHPP funds. The total project cost is \$7,000,000. (a separate proposal is being made to amend the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan to include this project);

Proposed Amendment 2020-04 to the TIP adds \$19,400,000 of S-STBG funds in FY 2023 for the ROW phase to TIP Project 2017-10, SR 2/ (US 11, N. Lee Highway). The project will widen to a 5-lane typical section from near Anatole Road to near SR-308, and a 3-lane typical section from near SR-308 to near Market Street;

The MPO will hold a public hearing on each of the proposed TIP amendments to receive and consider public comments on the proposed TIP amendments. The public hearing on proposed TIP Amendment 2020-04 will be held during the meeting of the MPO on June 22, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. in the 2nd floor City Council Meeting Room located at 190 Church Street NE, Cleveland, TN 37311. The public hearing on proposed TIP Amendment 2020-03 will be held during the meeting of the MPO on July 13, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. in the 2nd floor City Council Meeting Room located at 190 Church Street NE, Cleveland, TN 37311.
