Enclosed please find **Amendment 2020-03** to the Cleveland Urbanized Area MPO's FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment adds a new project to the TIP – **Bradley-McMinn County Project No. 2006015, I-75, ITS Infrastructure and Network Improvements**. The TIP Project Number is 2022-01 and the TDOT PIN for the project is 132290.00. Total project length is 22.86 miles. Funding for PE-N in FY 2023 is \$150,000 of NHPP funds and funding for PE-D in FY 2023 is \$350,000 of NHPP funds. The total project cost is \$7,000,000.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CLEVELAND URBAN AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation has enacted rules and regulations regarding urban transportation planning as reflected in 23 CFR § 450.320 and, thereby, establishing guidelines for the development, content, and processing of a cooperative developed Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) in urbanized areas; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Board of the Cleveland Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) approved the FY2020 - FY2023 TIP on November 6th, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the MPO requests an amendment to the FY2020-FY2023 TIP, described as:

Amendment 2020-03 to the 2020-2023 TIP adds a new project to the TIP, the Bradley-McMinn County Project No. 2006015, I-75, ITS Infrastructure and Network Improvements. Total project length is 22.86 miles from near SR-312 in Bradley County to near Coile Road (CR-114) in McMinn County. Funding for PE-N in FY 2023 is \$150,000 of NHPP funds and funding for PE-D in FY 2023 is \$350,000 of NHPP funds. The total project cost is \$7,000,000.

WHEREAS, the FY2020-FY2023 TIP remains financially constrained; and

WHEREAS, the MPO Technical Coordinating Committee and Executive Board have reviewed and approved these TIP amendments which underwent the public review and comment period as stated in the MPO Public Participation Plan, and no comments were received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Cleveland Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization does hereby approve the amendment to the FY2020-FY2023 TIP as presented above, and certifies that the planning process and public participation process addressing their inclusion has been conducted in accordance with all applicable requirements.

Metropolitan Transportation Planning Process Certification

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.336, the Cleveland Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Tennessee Department of Transportation hereby certify that the metropolitan transportation planning process is addressing major issues facing the Cleveland, TN urbanized area, and is being carried out in accordance with the following requirements:

- I. 23 U.S.C. 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 (Highways and Transit).
- II. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2000 d-1) and 49 CFR part 21.
- III. 49 U.S.C. 5332, prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, or age in employment or business opportunity.
- IV. Section 1101 (b) of the FAST-ACT (Pub. L 114-357) and 49 CFR part 26 regarding the involvement of disadvantaged business enterprises in USDOT-funded projects.
- V. 23 CFR part 230, regarding the implementation of an equal employment opportunity program on Federal and Federal-aid highway construction contracts.
- VI. Provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq) and 49 CFR parts 27, 37, and 38.
- VII. In nonattainment and maintenance areas, sections 174 and 176 (c) and (d) of the Clean Air Act, as amended, 42 U.S.C. 7504, 7506 (c) and (d), and 40 CFR part 93.
- VIII. The Older Americans Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 6101), prohibiting discrimination on the basis of age in programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance.
- IX. Section 324 of Title 23 U.S.C. regarding the prohibition of discrimination based on gender.
- X. Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794) and 49 CFR part 27 regarding discrimination against individuals with disabilities.
