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**I. November 2022 MINUTES – Discussion / Approval**

Annie Robbins seconded a motion by Pat Stone to approve the November 2022 Minutes. Motion passed without opposition.

**II. Updates & Reports**

- a. New Board Member – Commissioner Denny Collins was introduced as a new board member representing the County Commission, replacing Milan Blake.
- b. Chattanooga Gas Donation (\$20,000) – Fisher reported the check was presented on December 7, 2022 in a ceremony at the PIE Center.
- c. Etiquette Signs – Cameron Fisher tasked Corey with contacting the Sign Shop to replace the faded signs at each trailhead.
- d. Easement Procurements –
  - a. Corey Divel reported the closing of the four Stone parcels at Blythe & Ocoee; paid current taxes on property; deed recorded
  - b. Kathy Morelock is to meet w/ Corey and should have signature by next meeting
  - c. Corey is also working w/Dale Hughes and Duane Goff regarding their easements
- e. Phase VI -no update
- f. Light Pole Banners – new banners for the 2023-2025 period should be ordered next week and hung by mid-March
- g. Charleston Greenway – board discussed the report Fisher emailed and about logistics and timeframe of the project. Waiting until the mitigation is complete before moving forward with solid plans. There also needs to be discussion w/Wacker and TVA concerning their adjacent properties.
- h. Publicity Report – articles since the last meeting were presented.

**III. Rotary Centennial Project (Plaza)**

- a. Concept was presented and update given on progress of a quote for construction of the gateway arch and other features of the plaza
- b. Grant – a grant totaling \$20,000 has been applied for by the Cleveland Rotary Club toward the project.
- c. Timeframe – project will not begin until next year. City is being asked to hopefully have the greenway poured by that time to at least accommodate the location of the arch

**IV. Greenway Park: Deteriorating Conditions**

- a. Physical Updates
- b. Security Cameras/Policing (Fivas Update)
  - a. Three Cameras - all are working well:
    - 1. Facial Recognition
    - 2. Can go back 48 or 72 hours
    - 3. Pavilion - Front has a 360-degree feature
  - b. Next camera will be installed from Greenway Park going toward the Church of God campus
  - c. From Greenway going to Tinsley has a different voltage which needs to be worked out
  - d. Camera's have been ordered for Tinsley Park and the city is putting cameras at all parks

**V. Candies Creek Greenway - progress**

- a. HCI Grant Extension - approved to 6/30/2023
- b. Timeframe for Completion – project must be completed by 6/30/23 to obtain HCI funds

**VI. New Business (inquiries from community)**

- b. Outdoor Chapel - discussed, compared to a pavilion, no action taken
- c. Greenway Christmas Tree – discussion took place of designating a 'Greenway Christmas Tree' at a location to be decided later

  - b. Would need to decide if a new tree or current tree
  - c. Discussion of honoring Matthew Brown
- d. National Trails Conference – April 17 – 21 (Reno, NV)
  - a. Cameron will be attending the International Trails Summit in Reno, Nevada on April 17-21, 2023
